**Aroma:** Intense aromas reminiscent of black cherries, berries and cedar with subtle notes of toast and cocoa.

**Taste:** Medium - full-bodied with balance and elegance, its tannins are rounded and ripe.

**Food:** Delicious with roast chicken and vegetarian cheese dishes.
