2021 ~ 94 Points. "The 2021 Sauvignon Blanc Altura Máxima hails from Payogasta, Salta, a vineyard planted at a height of 10,200 feet in the middle of a desert right up on the Tropic of Capricorn. A steely light green in the glass. The remarkably intense nose offers asparagus, lime, rue and grass. In the mouth, it presents good fat and a malic, nimble flow, with the energy balanced out by the freshness. A surprising wine." - Antonio Galloni's Vinous, Aug/2022

OTHER INFO

At 3111 meters, the weather conditions are extreme, with late frosts in spring and early ones in autumn. Therefore, we plant varieties with short cycle such as Sauvignon Blanc, as exposure is a key factor to achieve a well-ripened fruit while keeping its freshness.



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
