Colour:	Straw yellow with golden reflections.
Aroma:	Intense citrus notes of cedar and grapefruit, followed by floral hints of orange blossom and delicate nuances of Mediterranean herbs.
Taste:	Vibrant freshness and pronounced minerality, with a long, savory finish enriched by elegant notes of almond and flint.
Food:	Seafood, fresh cheeses, and lighter vegetarian fare.

2022 ~ 91-92 Points. "A new project launched from Tommasi Family Estates titled Ammura is named after an Arabic word describing charming feminine attributes, because that is what Sicilian locals believe volcanic Mount Etna possesses. 100% made from the Carricante grape and aged in stainless steel. Brittle minerality, acidity and fruitiness in this wine with rounded characteristics; sweet and sour and with gentle, creamy flavors." - Tom Mullen - Forbes Magazine, Feb/2025

2022 ~ 91 Points. "Bright straw yellow with golden reflections. Finely characterised nose of chamomile blossom, juicy grapefruit and a hint of bitter almond in the background. 2022 ~ 91 Points. "Tree fruit and flower aromas bloom on the nose, of yellow apple, pear and citrus blossom, while an undertone of marzipan adds a denser element for balance. The palate is an apple and pear tart garnished with orange zest and shaved almonds, before a finish which turns savory with nuts and bitter citrus." - Danielle Callegari - Wine Enthusiast, Dec/2025

2022 ~ 90 Points. "The sweetly floral 2022 Etna Bianco opens with a pretty mix of freshly sliced nectarines, wild flowers, nuances of almond and wet stone. It washes across the palate with soft textures and ripe orchard fruits as salty mineral tones add lovely depth toward the close. The 2022 finishes fresh with a saline tinge and hints of sour citrus that pinch at the cheeks." - Eric Guido - Antonio Galloni's Vinous, May/2025

OTHER INFO

Production Area: Municipality of Linguaglossa (CT), Alboretto – Chiuse del Signore districts, northeast slope, vineyard altitude 650 meters above sea level.

Vineyard: Carricante, an indigenous variety grown in espalier training with a density of 4,200 plants per hectare, trained using the spur cordon system, with a yield of 70 quintals per hectare. Average vineyard age: 20 years.



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
