## **OTHER INFO**

Beyer Ranch has historically been a premier Livermore Valley location for Zinfandel. The estate vineyards are planted on carefully selected sites on the sloping benches that lead to the bans of the Arroyo del Valle and Arroyo Mocho streams. Grapes from these Zinfandel vineyards produce lustrous wines and deep richness. Each variety was fermented separately in stainless steel fermenters and were pumped over three times daily to maximize extraction of flavours and colours. The wine was aged for 20 months in neutral French and American oak barrels.
