Colour:	Deep ruby colour.
Aroma:	Ripe berry fruit aromas, with a touch of fruitcake and some cinnamon spice.
Taste:	The palate is dense with blackberry preserve and smoky oak flavours and lovely lingering fruit sweetness.
Food:	Great with roast game, or comfort food like casserole or a homemade steak.

OTHER INFO

Bleasdale Vineyards is Langhorne Creek's founding winery and Australia's second oldest family owned and operated winery. It was established in 1850 by English migrant Frank Potts, who arrived in South Australia on the Buffalo in 1836. The vineyards are situated on the flood plains of the Bremer River, which runs parallel to Langhorne Creek. Frank Potts sons and grandsons have operated the winery since, while building on his legacy. Bleasdale is solely owned and operated by fourth and fifth generation members of the Potts family.



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
