Colour: Intense garnet.

Aroma: Essence of menthol notes mixed with blackcurrant fruit and a range of wild

red forest fruit aromas.

Taste: Generous and seductive palate with a touch of spices mixed with redcurrant

and a hint of liquorice. The mouth is smooth and creamy all around, has an

expansive finish and displays well integrated soft tannins.

Food: Pairs well with grilled pork, braised short ribs, and beef stews.

The single parcel of Cabernet Sauvignon grows on the radiant slopes of the Sierra de l'Ombría where the sun shines 300 days a year. The 35 years old Cabernet Sauvignon thrives with the help of the Mediterranean cool wind swaying across the valley of Fontanares which regulates the fresh summer nights. Over the years the French varietal has slowly adapted its noble character with our Valencia terroir and, as a result, earned its unique personality.
