Colour:	Deep, vivid red.
Aroma:	Highly perfumed aromas of fresh raspberry, candied cherry and blood orange.
Taste:	Delicious, ripe, sweet, blast of fresh kirsch, black raspberries.
Food:	Pairs well with roasted meat, lamb chops and chicken.

### AWARDS & ACCOLADES

2021 ~ 97 Points. "Orange tint to the pale red. Extraordinary nose, like walking through a pine forest after the rain. Fine tannins and a gentle plumpness to the palate. Good acidity and a mineral note on the finish. Ethereal stuff, a beautiful Grenache. Grown on sand in Pignan nord, no destemming and a very light extraction, matured in demi-muids for 24 months. 3,200 bottles produced." - Matt Walls - Decanter, Sep/2022

2021 ~ 96 Points. "Transparent ruby purple with an orange tint. Orange peel, thyme and iodine, with some resinous notes from the forthright whole bunch influence. Not terribly full, fat or concentrated &ndash; it's just over medium-bodied, with a gentle fullness on the palate. Well-balanced acidity, with a herbal bitter note on the finish that's manifested since bottling. For me it doesn't detract from the wine, I love its strong personality; for some, the whole bunch element might be too marked in this cooler year. Sandy soils." - Matt Walls - Decanter, Dec/2023

2021 ~ 93-95 Points. "From 35-year-old Grenache in Pignan, vinified as whole clusters and then aged 24 months in older demi-muids, this is a floral, ethereal expression of Chateauneuf-du-Pape, marked by scents of roses, lavender, strawberry compote and hints of pine resin. Medium to full-bodied, it's silky-textured, sappy, slightly green-tinged, refreshing and long on the finish." - Joe Czerwinski - Robert Parker's Wine Advocate, Sep/2023

2021 ~ 93 Points. "A juicy burst of ripe, fresh cherry and crunchy red currant notes is anchored by bolts of smoldering iron and meatiness in this extroverted version. Shows good depth, concentration and length on the silky palate, with accents of salty earth, dried flowers, grilled cedar and sweet oak spice echoing on the svelte finish. Drink now through 2032." - Wine Spectator, Apr/2024

## OTHER INFO

The winery takes its name from a small Chapel that is more than 1,000 years old, located in the village of Chateauneuf du Pape. Chapelle St. Theodoric produces 3 red Chateauneuf du Pape wines from three uniquely different terroirs. Chapelle St. Theodoric Les Grans Pin is made from 100% Grenache planted in the sandy terroir of the Pignan Lieu-dit, located not far from Chateau Rayas. All the vineyards are farmed using 100% biodynamic farming techniques.



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
