TASTING NOTES

Colour: Deep crimson red.

Aroma: Rich bouquet with a fine perfume.

Taste: Medium-full bodied and elegant with flavours of ripe red berries, strawberry, raspberry, cherry, mocha and spice with some floral notes.

Food: Enjoy young, slightly chilled with roast turkey, chicken or veal. You will be able to appreciate it with stronger foods after several years of aging accompanying delicate meat dishes as well as most cheeses.

2023 ~ 91 Points. "A bright, lively and delicious gamay with sour cherries, red berries and warm spices on the nose, following through to a medium body with well-integrated tannins. Fruit-driven with a lovely floral lift on the palate and a fresh, racy finish." - James Suckling, Mar/2025

2022 ~ 92 Points. "Minerally and savory Moulin-a-Vent showing wet stone, bark, strawberry and rosemary aromas. It's medium-bodied, fresh and elegant with fine-grained tannins. Excellent length. Drink or hold." - James Suckling, May/2024

2022 ~ 91 Points. "The 2022 Moulin-à-Vent has a sapid, marine-tinged bouquet, hints of shucked oyster shell infusing the dark berry fruit. Fine delineation. The palate is medium-bodied with slightly furry tannins, spicier than the Morgon, with a little more edginess and pepperiness on the finish. Very fine." - Antonio Galloni's Vinous, Mar/2024

2022 ~ 90 Points. "The 2022 Moulin-à-Vent unfolds with aromas of cassis, stewed blackberries, violet petals, candied peel and subtle undertones of sandalwood. The medium to full-bodied palate presents a dark core of fruit built around chalky tannins." - Robert Parker's Wine Advocate, May/2024

2022 ~ 90 Points. "Packed with concentrated black cherry and blueberry flavour emboldened by smooth oak; with an attractive textured complexity and persistent finish." - Decanter World Wine Awards 2024

2021 ~ 92 Points. "The 2021 Moulin-à-Vent originates from eight different vineyards: Roche-grès, Carquelin, Champ de Cour, Thorins, Les Vérillats, La Roche, La Rochelle and Les Caves. It's a lush expression of the vintage, with a fruit-driven core of juicy red and black currants, cherries and red plums with top notes of lilac petals, dried sage, sweet spices and white pepper. On the medium-bodied palate, the tannins are finely woven, lending gentle support to the succulent, impressively concentrated flavors, making for a seamless, supple mouthfeel with a tangy finish. It's one of the most accessible wines from the estate's 2021 lineup." - Robert Parker's Wine Advocate, May/2024

2021 ~ 90 Points. "This has so much immediate red berry charm plus a touch of sour cherry. A bit on the light and crisp side for this appellation, but there are some nice restrained tannins supporting the fruit and harmonizing the stony acidity. Very well crafted. Drink now." - James Suckling, Feb/2023

2021 ~ 90 Points. "This wine pairs concentration and minerality. Black fruit predominates on the nose with raspberry, blackberry, umami and dried black cherry. The wine is grippy in texture and is supported by taut tannins through to the long finish. Drink now and from 2026 onwards to see the wine benefit from age in bottle." - Wine Enthusiast, Apr/2024

OTHER INFO

Following harvest, a portion of the grapes is destemmed before the wine is vinified in closed vats with pumping over. Finally, the wine matures for 8 months oak barrels (which is unusual for Beaujolais. Moulin-a-Vent can be enjoyed immediately or cellared for 10+ years.



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
