### TASTING NOTES

Colour: Deep red.

Aroma: Black fruits mixed with floral notes, and a subtle wood note to complete the nose.

Taste: Red cherry, red currant, chalk, smoke.

Food: Pot roast, buffalo burgers or filet mignon.

2014 ~ 91-93 Points. "The Chateau Fonroque 2014 blossoms from the glass with ebullient red berry fruit mixed with rose petal and violets aromas. The Fonroque estate stretches its 20 hectares over several hundred metres to the north-west of the village of Saint-Emilion. The vineyard covers 17.6 hectares in a single piece of land that spreads across a plateau and a west-facing hillside.
