The three varieties used for Chic come from the Penedes region. The climate is Mediterranean, with mild winters and warm summers. The Penedes baja is the hottest region due to its proximity to the sea. The climate is cooler in the Central and Penedes Alta, with the latter being more hilly and with a slight continental climate.
