Colour: Very deep garnet-red colour almost black.

Aroma: The nose is full with aromas of very ripe black fruit.

Taste: It is gourmand with liquorice aromas and a spicy finish.

Food: A variety of meats, either grilled, roast, braised or stewed. Also pairs nicely with both hard and soft cheeses.

In 2008: Pierre Henri found a fantastic terroir on the mythical "Pignan" district in Chateauneuf du Pape and they purchased 4 hectares of a single vineyard. This was the first stone of a range of wines truly representative of the southern Rhone and more especially Grenache expression.



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
