Aroma: The fragrance is very fruity and rich with cherry notes.

Taste: The taste is medium body but very intense, spicy with smooth and full of flavours.

"Graticcio" is the term for the traditional bamboo racks used for air-drying grapes after the harvest; a technique that concentrates the flavours in the grapes." - Natalie Maclean, May/2021

Tommasi viticoltori is located in Pedemonte, a small village in the heart of the 'Valpolicella Classico region, in the northwest part of Verona. From grandfather Giacomo Tommasi's tiny vineyard, the Tommasi estate has grown steadily over the course of years and today it extends over 195 hectares of hillside vineyards blessed by Mother Nature for its perfect suitability for grapes.

This wine is produced with grapes selected from the Venetian regions, a part of which are partially dried before being gently pressed.



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
