Colour:	Intense ruby.
Aroma:	Small black berries (blackcurrant, blackberry), violet and hints of licorice.
Taste:	Soft attack, with aromas of red fruit. The backbone of this wine is its minerality. The finish is long and spicy.
Food:	Grilled steak or chicken.

2016 ~ 92 Points. "The 2016 Saint Joseph Lieu-Dit Saint Joseph features attractive aromas of crushed stone, black olives, black cherries and roasted meat. Medium to full-bodied, it's velvety in texture, with a long, cedar and vanilla-tinged finish. Already approachable, it should drink well for the next 10-12 years." - Robert Parker's Wine Advocate, Oct/2018

2016 ~ 92 Points. "Leading off the Saint Joseph releases and from multiple vineyards throughout the appellation, the 2016 Saint Joseph La Source offers loads of burning embers, blackberries, licorice and roasted herb characteristics. With medium to full-bodied richness and ripe, present tannin, it's another balanced, classic wine from Ferraton to drink over the coming decade." - Jeb Dunnuck, Dec/2018

2016 ~ 90 Points. "A blend of several parcels, this has quite a savory feel with wet slate, cocoa and black pepper, dusted across an array of rich red plums. The palate has elegance with fine-grained tannins, holding a firmish finish. Try from 2022." - James Suckling, Oct/2019

OTHER INFO

Soil is slightly acid granite on the right bank of the Rhone, on the foothills of the Massif Central. Grapes are destemmed and macerated for about 20 days. Extraction made by pumping over and punching down. Maturing in oak barrels and vats for 12 months before bottling.
