Colour:	Deep maroon.
Aroma:	On the nose, ripe red berry fruit aromas come to the fore enhanced by more complex characters coming from the oak ageing.
Taste:	Fresh and silky on the palate with good volume and excellent structure.
Food:	Serrano-ham-based tapas, fatty fish such as salmon, or grilled pork chops.

Mencia grapes are selected from vineyards located in different areas of Bierzo where careful vine-growing, the right altitude and good exposure enable perfect ripening of the grapes. The vineyards are planted in different soil-types, most of which are either made up of fragmented slate (such as in Campo and Molinaseca) or clay (as in Valtuille and Villadecanes).



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
