Colour: Medium ruby.

Aroma: Inviting aromas of red fruit, highlighted by bright, fresh plum and red

cherry. Subtle notes of toffee and coffee bean intertwine, leading to a

delicate undercurrent of white pepper.

the palate with the harmonious fusion of red fruit flavors and a touch of oak. A seamless finish lingers gracefully, showcasing the perfect balance

between fruitiness and a touch of spice.
