- Aroma: On the nose, heaps of ripe Okanagan plums and black cherries lift from the bouquet.
- Taste: On the palate, this full-bodied Pinot offers a tremendous concentration of jammy plum and berry fruit, hints of chocolate and spice, complemented by soft velvety tannins, framed with French oak.
- Food: Ideal with mushroom-based dishes, salmon and pork.

OTHER INFO

The Optimum Pinot Noir is a selection of the best of each year's harvest.

Located in the Okanagan's premier grape region, Gehringer Brothers Estate Winery is nestled in the heart of the well-known Golden Mile area south of Oliver. It is tucked in among five neighbouring wineries, overlooking an expanse of vineyard and orchards as far as Osoyoos Lake.

The vineyard's southeast aspect and gentle slope gives the vines excellent exposure to sunshine, while the elevated location on the bench keeps the vines safely above the fall frost zone of the valley floor. The high mountain slopes behind the vineyards to the west provide evening shade, resulting in a rapid cool-off during summer, which in turn prevents grape acid levels from falling. This is what shapes the Gehringer style: a fine balance between ripe, sweet fruit and firm, clean acidity.
