TASTING NOTES

Colour: Bright lemon yellow.

Aroma: Grilled hazelnuts and minerals on the nose.

Taste: This elegant premier cru is marked by focused ripe peach and pear fruit in a refined, old-vine structure with notes of spice, grilled hazelnuts and minerals on the nose and palate, with a layered, lasting finish.

Food: Shell fish dishes, such as lobster or crabmeat in a light wine sauce, salmon, trout or Dover Sole simply grilled or poached.

AWARDS & ACCOLADES

2022 ~ 91-93 Points. "Aromas of pear, green apple, citrus zest, white flowers and freshly baked bread introduce the 2022 Puligny-Montrachet 1er Cru Garenne (Duc de Magenta), a medium to full-bodied, satiny and lively wine that's more harmonious and complete than the regular Garenne." - William Kelley - Robert Parker's Wine Advocate, Jan/2024

2022 ~ 91-93 Points. "The 2022 Puligny-Montrachet Clos de la Garenne 1er Cru has a more backward bouquet than the Garenne, though there is a little more nuance and terroir expression here. The palate is well-balanced with a silver bead of acidity and more mineralité than the La Grenne, but there is also more strictness and linearity on the finish. 2022 ~ 90 Points. "Peach and lemon flavors are framed by butter and vanilla in this plump, juicy white. The vibrant, underlying structure keeps this lively and drives the long, spice-filled aftertaste." - Bruce Sanderson - Wine Spectator, Nov/2025

2020 ~ 95 Points. "Clos de la Garenne is located within Champ Canet, above Clos de la Mouchère, where Domaine Duc de Magenta has 0.84ha of 80-year-old vines that Jadot rents. Lightly crushed and fermented in cask (25% new), this gives a powerful wine, citrussy and crisp, with immense concentration and a very lively balance, even in the heat of 2020. A marvellous wine and something to seek out." - Decanter, May/2021

2019 ~ 94 Points. "Concentrated flavors of white peach and apricot are swirled into hazelnut and sweet cream in this ripe Chardonnay. Deeper reaching, ephemeral nuances of earth and stone here are a step up from Jadot's village-level Puligny. Fresh and mineral on the finish, the wine should develop beautifully through 2034 and hold further still." - Wine Enthusiast, Dec/2021

OTHER INFO

Puligny-Montrachet, situated to the south of Meursault and to the north of Chassagne-Montrachet, shares with Chassagne a handful of the greatest white wine vineyards in the world. The grand crus of Le Montrachet and Batard-Montrachet straddle the border between the two communes; those of Chevalier-Montrachet and Bienvenues-Batard-Montrachet lie entirely within Puligny. Of the commune's 1,260 acres of A.O.C. vineyards, 52 are occupied by these four grand crus.



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
