This is authentic Chile, and when it comes to cabernet sauvignon, it is also real, as in really good. The series is a prime example of what can be done in Chile, as demonstrated by this smoky, cedar, cassis, cabernet sauvignon nose from fruit farmed at 700 meters above sea level. The attack is intense with savoury boldo, black cherries, and bay leaves dominating. The texture is a highlight, rich and long, so silky and stylish it's hard to believe this is cabernet sauvignon. The spice, tobacco, and mineral tone rule a long, satisfying finish. Impressive and nowhere near reaching its peak, this wine will repay any bottle time through 2028. The nose offers black currant and cedar and a hint of bay leaf. In the mouth, this is compact with grippy tannins and intense flavor. T.H. stands for Terroir Hunter. Grapes were sourced from a selected vineyard in Pirque in the Alto Maipo area. This is located at the foot of the andes Mountain range on the Eastern edge of the Maipo Valley, which is world famous for its perfect climate for red wines.
